Meeting called order at 6:35

Henry Grimes brought up that we need to revisit the item in 2/9 minutes about 7v7 for 2015 since we will be playing this season.

Shannon Davidson motioned to accept the 2/9/15 meeting minutes. Chris Carrado 2nd. Unanimous

Grimes has filed the 5013c paperwork with the state which includes the name change to Bobcat Youth Football Organization. Once we are approved we will set up with bank.

Grimes said that Jannica Morton is in the final phases of the website and it should be up in a day or two.

Jeremy Corr and Allie Jones discussed fundraising. Corr has a league fundraiser of Bobcat gear. If 200 children sell 5 items we will make enough to pay off Riddell. Jones will have the chance for cheer moms to sell the mix bags to help supplement their registration fees. Each child will get 50% profit on sold items. This will run April 11th-May 1st. Jones is going to look into dates for football parents to participate.

Corr showed the sample of the jersey for the 2015 season. They are \$32 each. The sample was approved.

Jones discussed that cheer would hold a swap for cheer uniforms. Each piece will be \$25. Several 1st and 2nd grade parents were upset they had to order a new uniform this year. It was proposed that 1st-3rd use the old uniform this year and 4th-6th use a new uniform. Shannon Davidson motioned, Jones 2nd. Unanimous

Corrado gave a status update on football. He is only waiting for our current year insurance information and Heads Up Football will be ready to go. Paul Hosni to be the Master Trainer. Heads Up clinic will be mandatory for all coaches. There are currently 9 sign-ups for people interested in being head and assistant coaches. He is working on getting camps together. There are currently 11 people signed up for 7 on 7 online. Coppell to get figures for the cost per player. Grapevine will manage league. NWPA will participate as part of BYFO for 7 on 7. Corrado to try to reach out to NWPA to let them know they can play.

Dean Murry has designed a door hanger to advertise cheer and football sign-ups. It will be \$500 to distribute.

Joey Edwards was appointed by Grimes to be the Director of Marketing. Board approved unanimously.

Cheer registration will be 4/11 and 4/25. The mixed bag fundraiser has been set up. Jones is currently working with Miss Love from BNHS to set up cheer camp.

Davidson motioned to change BYFA to BYFO on the bylaws. Maclaine Robinson 2nd. Unanimous
